District Information: Burkeville is a Class A district nestled among the tall pines of Northern Newton County. The District is composed of 301 square miles in the heart of beautiful East Texas. The East side of the District is bordered by the Sabine River, which is the state line between Texas and Louisiana. Toledo Bend Dam and Lake provides fishing, hiking, and recreation on the Northern border with Sabine County.

The Burkeville Area is truly a Sportsman's Paradise with the largest man made lake in the South, Toledo Bend, connected with Lake Sam Rayburn just 20 miles to the West by scenic TX-R255. Burkeville is a community of ethnic diversity supported by the satellite communities of Toledo Bend, Jamestown, Shankleville, Wiergate, Farrsville, and Mayflower. Educationally, the area is supported by Angelina Junior College, Stephen F. Austin, and Lamar Universities. Burkeville ISD is also served by Region 5 Education Service Center.

The professional staff consists of four administrators, a librarian, and a counselor. There are 36 teachers (K-12) classified by the Texas Education Agency as Highly Qualified. Support personnel include four office clerks, a nurse, 15 teacher aides, and 19 auxiliary support staff.

Burkeville ISD has an average enrollment of 325 students (PK-12). Ethnicity is approximately 65% Anglo, 34% African American, and 1% Hispanic. Enrollment has declined slowly since 1986. Average Daily Attendance ranges about 97%.

Burkeville ISD has an annual budget of approximately \$4.3 million. Per pupil expenditure exceeds \$5,000.

Qualifications: The district seeks a candidate who has:

1. a valid Texas Superintendent Certification
2. at least five years classroom teaching experience and a successful tenure as a campus-level principal and/or central office administrator.
3. a working knowledge of budgeting and public school finance.
4. demonstrated strong skills in educational leadership.
5. a strong background in student performance success.
6. integrity and exemplary moral character along with excellent people skills.

How to Apply: Applicants should submit a letter of interest, a BISD application (may be printed from schools website: www.burkeville.org), and resume that includes a complete work history, educational background, list of all relevant certifications, a complete transcript, and a minimum of eight (8) references. References should include addresses, job description, and a daytime phone number.

Salary/Benefits: Salary, benefits, and contract commensurate with experience and regional salary ranges.

Moving Expenses: Moving expenses may be negotiated up to \$2,500.
